Site Location & Description

Rose Hill Court is a residential development of 20 houses located in the townland of Marnellsmeadows towards the south-western side of Kilkenny City. The development is accessed via the Circular Road (Local Road L-2670) close to the intersection with the College Road and Callan Road. The house types are two-storey detached, two-storey terraced and dormer terraced dwellings.

Planning History

This development could be considered historic at this point in time. The development was constructed approximately 25 years ago in the early 1990's on foot of Kilkenny Corporation Planning Permission P90/990070. The permission was for 28 dwellings – although only 20 were constructed.

TIC Request:

The company responsible for this development, Kilcreene Engineering Limited, was dissolved on 9th April 1999. The request to take the development in charge was received from the Rose Hill Court Resident's Association on 25th November 2011. The application was made to the former Borough Council and was signed by a majority of the residents within the development. Remedial works have been carried out by Kilkenny County Council with funding secured from the Department of Housing, Planning, Community & Local Government under the National Taking in Charge Initiative.

Recommendation:

Having regard to the fact that the estate has been substantially completed in accordance with conditions attached to the grant of permissions, I recommend that Kilkenny County Council initiate proceedings for the formal Taking-in-Charge of Rose Hill Court, Circular Road as highlighed on the attached map.
